DHC-2 Beaver is known as the best bush seaplane ever built.

The Beaver may carry up to 7 people and is mostly used for the transportation of 5 plus luggage.

It is an aircraft that has short take offs and landings capability, very impressive.

It allows a wide flexibility for bush operation. The industry celebrated the Beaver's 50 years in 1998 and designated it as one of the 10 biggest technical realization of the 20th century.

Our Beaver:

Very comfortable in VIP 5 pax configuration, it offers up to seven seats and only ours have two luggage compartments and two others in the floats.

Our seaplanes are amphibious, that is to say that our seaplanes can also use airports.
